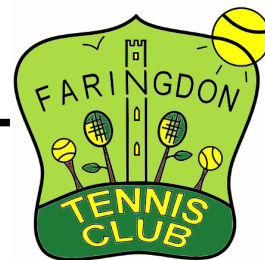


Faringdon Tennis Club
